ECCE Eligibility

September 2022 - June 2023

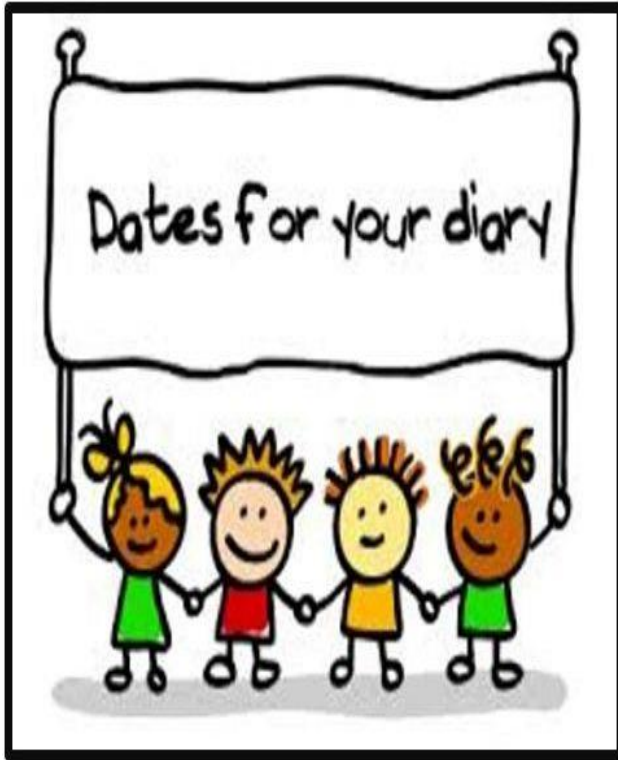


All children born between 01st January 2018 and 31st December 2019 will be eligible for the ECCE Scheme from September 2022. All ECCE classes and waiting lists are full. If your child is already attending Kathy b's and will be eligible for ECCE from September 2022 you do not need to do anything. There is no option to switch from an afternoon to a morning place. I will email you any forms you need to complete.

I am finalising class times, teachers, and sessions for 2022/23. Once St. Kilian's N.S. confirm their school calendar I will be in touch with details of our back-to-school date, your child's class time and teacher for September 2022.

After School September 2022

Our Breakfast Club & Afterschool and our waiting list is full for September 2022. If you no longer need a place for September, please let me know as soon as possible. I will email you a September 2022 After School Registration Form shortly. You will need to complete and return this along with your child's deposit for September 2022. A deposit of €100 will be required per family which will be refunded 4 weeks after each After School child starts back in September.



Easter Holidays - all classes will finish for Easter on Friday, April 8th. We reopen on Monday, April 25th. Wishing you all a very Happy Easter.

Graduation for Montessori children will take place on Thursday June 30th. We are delighted to be able to invite families of graduating children to join us for our celebration this year. It is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate this special occasion with your child, their friends, and their teacher. There will be lots of photo opportunities of the children in their graduation caps and gowns.

We will record the graduation songs with the children in the week before and this recording will be played on Graduation Day for all families to enjoy. It will also be emailed to families of graduating children to keep as a special memory.

Further details, including timings will be confirmed closer to the date.

To facilitate Graduation Day please note there will be NO MONTESSORI CLASSES on Thursday, June 30th. The only children attending this day will be children who are graduating from Kathy b's who will attend for their allotted Graduation Party time only.

This means that all non-Graduating children will finish up for Summer on Wednesday 29th June 2022. This is something we do every year to facilitate Graduation Day and each child's turn will come around when they get to attend the final day and have their Graduation Party.

Please note Breakfast Club (for After School children only) and After School will run as usual this day and we will collect our After Schoolers at the earlier times from St. Kilian's N.S.

If your child usually attends After School on a Thursday, please email me to confirm if they will be attending on Thursday 30th June and what time they will need to be picked up at from St. Kilian's.
